# Yacht Club Sempachersee: Inseli-Race 2023

The Inseli regatta on Whit Monday took place with somewhat sporty wind conditions. As the fleet of 32 boats set off towards the island, some 5 km distant, the wind was on the beam and about Beaufort force 2, but soon increased to a gusty force 4-5. Conditions as we rounded the island were challenging and the return journey was fast and exciting!

Our three Dinghies acquitted themselves well finishing in the middle of the fleet on corrected time. We enjoyed a competitive race within a race with positions changing frequently - after a race lasting 1 hour 9 minutes only 38 seconds separated winner Hans, second place Toni and my *Einepyk* in third place.

Serge Patry has confirmed that Mayu's Dinghy *Sylvia* has now returned to its 'birthplace' the Chantier Naval de Corsier Port, where it will be restored prior to participating in the *Journée du patrimoine Corsier Port* on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> of September. Thought to have been built in 1920, *Sylvia* is probably the oldest surviving Dinghy in Switzerland.

## Journée du patrimoine Corsier Port

We and our Dinghies are invited to participate in the *Journée du patrimoine Corsier Port* on September 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.

# Full details will be published later, but Serge Patry tells us that:

The Journée du patrimoine will feature:

- animation and exhibitions on land, and entertainment on the water with the motorboats of the foundation offering rides.
- a series of short informal regattas and parades which this year will be mostly for small boats, namely 12' Dinghies and Moucherons, plus a few larger boats.
- On Saturday evening a dinner will be organised for the participants.
- Whilst the port of Corsier is not very big there is plenty of space on land which can easily accommodate around fifteen 12' Dinghies which will be taken out of the water each evening via the adjacent public ramp. The site also has all the logistical facilities of a port as well as showers and toilets.
