



News from Neuhaus

Rules

- The regatta is governed by the rules as set out in the "Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024".
- The supplementary Swiss Sailing rules apply. Any rule changes will be described in the Sailing Instructions.
- The protected areas of Lake Sempach must be observed.

Advertising

Category C advertising applies.

Eligibility

- Competitors must be members of an ISAF affiliated club.
- The Swiss Sailing regulations apply to Swiss participants. Licenses can be obtained in the regatta office.

- Entry fee: 35 SFr. / per boat Late registration fee: 10 SFr. / per boat

Measurement checks

Random measurement checks can be carried out by the race committee or the jury.

Race schedule

Saturday May 28, 2022

09:00 - 11:30 a.m. Registration at the regatta office, delivery of sailing instructions

12:00 p.m. Skippers meeting

 $1:\!00\ p.m.$ Announcement signal for the first race

Further races will be sailed as soon as possible after the previous race finishes.

Sunday May 29, 2022

09:00 a.m. readiness for departure

3:30 p.m. Last possible start time

Number of races: Max 6 (max. 4 per day)

Scoring

- One completed race is required for the series to be declared valid.
- Discards: When four or more valid races have been completed.

Prizes

Commemorative prizes for all participants

Berths and parking spaces

- Moorings and parking spaces according to the indications on site.
- Camping is not allowed in the club area! There is an excellent campsite nearby

Social arrangements

- Free beer/bottled water on Saturday May 28, 2022
- Dinner/Apero in the clubhouse (registration required by Monday, May 23, 2022 you will be prompted for this when registering your boat)
- "Buvette" catering at the YCSe club

Liability and Insurance

- Persons participating in this regatta do so at their own risk
- Each participating boat must have sufficient liability insurance valid for racing risks.

Participants agree that audio and video recordings may be made at the event and these can be published (e.g., website, newspaper, etc.). Furthermore, the registration, results and other information about the event (including the names of the participants) may be published.

Sailing Rules

The races will be held according to the rules of World Sailing (WR) and the sailing regulations of the Lake Thun and Lake Brienz Sailing Association (TBSV).

Registration

Online registration, registration on site and payment at the regatta office of the TYC on Saturday between 11.00 a.m. and 12.30 p.m.

Entry Fees

Dinghies CHF 45, single-handed dinghies CHF 35.

Number of boats

A class must have entered at least 8 boats for a regatta weekend to be held. For further classes at least 5 boats are required. The race committee and the head of sport reserve the right merge multiple classes into a single race start..

Start Times

1st race: Saturday, 2 p.m.

For subsequent races see signals on the committee boat - and pay attention to the bulletin board! Last possible start on Sunday: at the discretion of the race committee but not later than 3:30 p.m.

Number of races

A maximum of eight valid races are sailed per weekend. Above four valid runs one result will be discarded.

Prize Giving

After the end of the last race in the TYC area.

Liability

By registering and participating in a regatta, each participant waives each participant on the assertion of liability claims of any Art to the TYC, the person responsible for the conduct of the regatta people and the helpers deployed.

Media Rights, Cameras and Electronic Equipment

By participating in this event, the participants transfer to the Organizer and its sponsors without compensation unlimited rights to create, use and show moving images, live recordings, recorded or filmed TV recordings and other recordings of the athletes or their boats produced during the event.
